

FAQ: What is the Kick Type toggle on the back of the DM6 module for?



The Kick Type toggle* sets the module to receive either a SWITCH signal or PAD signal from a kick trigger in order to play a sound.

- Note that the <u>DM6 USB Kit</u> and <u>DM6 USB Express Kit</u> are packaged with a PAD-style kick trigger and the KICK TYPE should be set to PAD.
- Examples of a 'pad' kick triggers are the DMPad Kick Pad and the RealHead Kick Pad.
- An example of a 'switch' kick trigger is the DMHat Pedal.
- If the toggle is set to SWITCH, the module will not receive signals from a PAD-style kick trigger and therefore will not play sound.
- If the KICK TYPE is set to PAD, the module will not receive signals from a SWITCH-style kick trigger and therefore will not play sound.
- If you are not getting any sound out of your kick, try toggling from SWITCH to PAD or vice versa.
